TYRANNOSAURUS REX

This dinosaur **DIDN'T FIGHT (not/fight)** other dinosaurs very often, but it **PROTECTED (protect)** itself from danger with its horns.

The Parkasaurus **BELONGED (belong)** to the Late Triassic period. It **WAS (be)** a herbivore with a long neck, but its body **WASN'T (not/be)** very large. The Parkasaurus **HAD (have)** a small head and a long tail for balance. It **DIDN'T RUN (not/run)** fast, but it **STAYED (stay)** safe by staying in groups.
